

Intermediate Acrylic Painting Supply List

- A pencil and your large media sketchbook
- 9" x 12" canvas or canvas board for each class and some small surfaces for exercises – this could be watercolor paper primed with gesso
- An assortment of brushes intended for acrylic paint (usually long handled with white bristles)
- A palette knife
- Such as: #6 Filbert, a #6, one small round #2 and a 1 ½" or 2" utility brush for gesso
- Flat palette for mixing paint (freezer paper or palette paper)
(avoid the ones with small circles – they work best with watercolor)
- Apron or smock
- Rags or paper towels

You will need 7 tubes of paint:

- Hansa or Lemon Yellow
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Ultramarine Blue
- A greenish blue such as Thalo or Teal
- Pyrrole Red or Cadmium Red Medium or Primary Red
- Quinacridone Magenta or Alizarin Crimson
- Titanium White

- Gesso (small)
- Matte Gel Medium
