Paper:

Watercolor block -Arches 140lb Cold-pressed, 10"x 14", 12"x 16", or 18"x 24" whichever size is most comfortable - no drawing board necessary for stability Sheet Paper - Arches 140lb Cold-pressed or Lanaquarelle and Saunders 140lb Cold-pressed 22"x 30" bring a drawing board for mounting - a 15" x 22" sheet of foam board works great (It isn't necessary to purchase professional grade paper if you don't have it. A pad of student grade 140lb paper is fine.)

Brushes:

11/2" or 2" wash brush1" flat brush, beveled handle#8, #10, or #12 roundRigger brush - any size suggested - Cheap Joe's Lizard LickSynthetic or synthetic blend brushes suggested - Cheap Joe's Dream Catcher series

Palette:

Large palette with lid for mixing and storing suggested - John Pike palette
